To the Sheriff of Washington Gle

We command you that you take George Howard - if in your Bailwick  
And him safely keep so that you have him before the Justices of our Court  
Of pleas and Sessions to be held on the fourth Monday in February - next  
Then and there to answer John Hamilton of a plea of Trespass upon  
the Case and so forth, to the Damage of the said John Hamilton  
and four thousand Pounds and so forth.  
Herein fail not and have you there this Verit Witness John Sevier  
Clerk of our said Court at his Office the 24<sup>th</sup> day of November anno D<sup>o</sup>  
-om, 1778. The fourth year of American Independance  
Spruce Macay Att. for Plaintiff. John Sevier Clk
