 this twenty-third day of June, 1865, at Petersburg
 Virginia by reason of Order of War Dept. May 29, 1865.
 (No objection to his being re-enlisted is known to exist.)

Said Myron Kennedy was born in Pamplia,
 in the State of N. C., is nineteen years of age,
 five feet eleven inches high, light complexion, gray eyes,
 red hair, and by occupation, when enrolled, a Farmer.
