Order is taken this <sup>16<sup>th</sup></sup> 17 day of July  
1668. By vertue of His Majesties Letters  
of Privy Seal, dated the sixteenth day of Fe-  
bruary 1666. That you deliver and pay of  
such His Majesties Treasure as is or shall be  
remaining in your Charge of His Majesties  
Revenue, arising by the Duty of Fire-  
hearths, unto Sir George Carteret, Knight  
and Baronet, or his Assignes, the Summe  
of Two thousand pounds by way  
of Imprest and upon Accompt in part of the  
Summe of 425833 l. 6 s. 8 d. for providing Sea-  
batteries, as in the said Privy Seale is ex-  
pressed. And these together with the Ac-  
counts of the said Sir George Carteret, or  
his Assignes shall be your discharge herein.
