Also, in consideration of North Carolina Indent^y, to double
that amount, which I have paid & delivered to him,
& which for value rec'd, as aforesaid, I do by ^{warrant} ~~hereby~~,
& discharge, to be receivable in payment for Land,
granted by the State of North Carolina — And,
I do hereby, in consideration of five Shillings,
to me now in Hand paid by the said Ephraim
Shattocks myself, to assign & deliver to him, his
sons Edmund, Thomas or Lesquis, S^t Carolina
Indent^y, / to be receivable in payment for Land,
granted by that State, to double the amount
of such S^t Carolina Indent^y, not exceeding
