 Sterling, in consideration of North Carolina Indenture, to double  
 that amount, which I have paid & delivered to him,  
 & which for value recd, as aforesaid, I do hereby <sup>warrant</sup> ~~promise~~  
 & engage, to be receivable in Payment for Land,  
 granted by the State of North Carolina — and  
 I do hereby, in consideration of two Shillings,  
 to me now in Hand paid by the said Ephraim  
 Mitchell's promise, to assign & deliver to him, his  
 Sons & assigns Attorneys or Assignees, North Carolina  
 Indenture, to be receivable in payment for Land,  
 granted by that State, to double the amount  
 of such North Carolina Indenture, not exceeding  
 £1135. Sterling # as he or they shall assign,  
 deliver, or tender, to us, on or before the  
 day of <sup>not</sup> immediately upon such  
 shipment & delivery or tender — Charleston  
 North Carolina August 29. 1786
