THE STATE of SOUTH-CAROLINA. To all and singular the Sheriffs of the
said State, GREETING: You, and each of you, are hereby commanded, without Delay, to attach the Body of

John Withers

wherefoever *he* may be found, within your and each of your respective Districts, so that you compel *him* to be and appear
before the Justices of the said State, at the Court of Common Pleas, to be holden at Charleston, on the *First* ~ ~ ~ Tuesday
in *July* ~ ~ ~ next, to answer to

*Anthony Toomer, of a Plea of Trespass on the case and soforth; also for certain promises
and Assumptions by the said John Withers to the said Anthony Toomer made
and not performed to his Damage Two Hundred and Fifty Pounds Sterling.*

And have you then and there this Writ.

WITNESS the honorable *Thomas Stuyward August Esquire, one of the Associate Justices*
at Charleston, the Eighteenth Day of March ~ ~ ~ *in the Year of our Lord One Thousand Seven Hundred*
and Eighty-Eight and in the Twelfth ~ ~ ~ *Year of the Sovereignty and Independence of the United States of America.*
