Wilmington July 23. 1817.

My Dear Son,

The information contained  
in this letter you must on no account  
communicate to any other person, even  
the most intimate friend you have.

You may expect to see me  
in New-York in ten days, or two weeks  
at farthest, to embark on board the  
Ontario, for her present voyage, as I  
have been appointed by the President  
on an important mission. I want to  
know how you are getting on  
at this time. If there be any thing you want  
to bring home, let me know, that I may  
bring it on with me when I come.

Let me know whether your  
new is completed, & whether you have  
got all your stores on board. k. k.
