Extract of a
Genl Order

New Quarter New Orleans
June 1st 1809 —

The Commanding Officers of Companies are without delay to furnish the District Paymaster Description lists of all men born on their Rolls when last mustered to exhibit state of enlistment, by whom enlisted & what time last paid and by whom, amount of Bounty paid and the amount of Bounty due. These lists are essential to the safety of the Paymaster as well as to the interest of the Troop and must be rendered by Monday next.

Major McAbee will furnish the District Paymaster with an Order until further Orders

Capt. Cutler has leave of absence to visit the City of Washington and report himself to the Secretary of War

The Paymaster is to settle with him up to the present day
