Geo. Town, Sep. 5. 1800

I have received your letter of the 2^d Instant, in which were enclosed \$200, which is paid to your Credit, I will attend to your instructions respecting the freight of Capt. Clarke when he arrives. — Mr. Wood has not yet paid me the \$150 you advanced him, several of the Clerks are getting Discounts at our Banks in Anticipation of their Quarters Salary, I suppose Mr. Wood will pay it when he receives his Salary,
