Albany 9 Apr. 1814

The letters by your Steam boat of Thursday have not
yet been delivered, nor do I know that the boat

total rejection of my bill in the Senate - there is
no probability that it will be revised -

on Thursday Mr Camb of Essex Sud. was
30 given in favor of Clason in Stratwell & Jada.
of S. C. reversed - Kent claimed & exercised
the right of voting - He read a very elaborate
opinion of nearly one hour manifesting extreme
solicitude & irritation - He got 3 votes -
evidence for verifying
