Albany 9 Apr. 1814

The letter by your Steamboat of Thursday have not yet been delivered, nor do I know that the boat has arrived -

My last (6th) informed you of the total rejection of my bill in the Senate - there is no probability that it will be renewed -

On Thursday Dr. Court of Errors Jud. was 30 gain in favor of Classen vs Shattock & Jas. G. S. C. reversed - Kent claimed & exercised the right of voting - He had a very elaborate opinion of nearly one hour manifesting extreme solicitude & irritation - He got 3 votes - 21 votes for confirming -
