Oct. 4. 1818. - I promise to pay R. B. Toney  
one hundred dollars, as soon as a deed  
is obtained from Henry Deakley to me

a bill in Frederick County Court. - The  
said R. B. Toney is to have nothing but  
legal costs unless I obtain the land. -
