I have the honor to state
that my command is on the way,
I will strike the Flat Shoals & Jones-
town road, at a point less about four
miles from Flat Shoals, between Flat
shoals & Jones town - It is so dark
that the Command is necessarily compelled
to move slowly, I fear my Cavalry
will find great difficulty in reaching
you owing to the darkness -
