Camp near Mickey's  
April 4 1862

General:

The Cavalry & Infy of  
the enemy attacked Colo Clanton's regiment  
which was posted as I before informed  
you about 500 or 600 yards in advance  
of my lines. Colo Clanton retired & the  
enemy's cavalry followed until they  
came near our Infy & Arty where they  
were gallantly repulsed with slight loss.
