- Carlisle suggested the information about the Frye Mission in bulletin ahead of time so people will be prepared to give.
- Sylvia Page suggested the information about Epworth ahead of time for people to be prepared to give.
- Carlisle Dawsey reported he will have the information about Epworth next year about Thanksgiving time.
- 14. Brad Dusenbury made motion to accept the budget with the changes: Christmas Gifts \$1600.00 to be added to budget and increase the reserve for capital improvements to \$25,000. Joanne Joyner second. Motion carried.
- Rev. Mardis we stopped short on not letting the budget committee look into how we can address some practical way to improve our budget.
- Darrell Ricketts suggested the trustee's needs to look into the sound system for the elders.
- 17. Kat James reported it had been discussed that the Friendship Class would move to a classroom. Ken Frye said the Friendship Class agreed to move to a classroom. Phyllis Morrison reported the Altman Class would move to the old nursery and the Friendship Class move into the Altman Class room. The nursery to move across the hall.

Pastor's Notes Church Council Meeting December 16, 2007

## 1. Bahamas Mission Trip

Due to a change in plans by several who had made financial commitments, this trip has cancelled. The original idea was to target youth and young adults. The majority of teams involved in the Bahamas are youth teams during the summer. Of the dozen or so persons who originally expressed interest, only one was in the youth age group. When financial commitments were called for, eight persons paid deposits. A few weeks ago, both of the slots held for one family were cancelled and this put the mission team under strength. Finally a couple of weeks ago, another adult cancelled — so this put the remaining members under our needed number. While I am disappointed that we could not bring this effort to fruition, thankfully, none of the team's money had been put on deposit that could not be refunded

Recommendation: The money received during our Thanksgiving meal (\$400.00 plus), was given toward mission efforts and should remain as mission money, held for the West Virginia effort or some future mission endeavor. The only other option for those who gave by check is that they be offered a possible refund if desired.

## 2. Compass Project

During the last Council meeting, approval was given to proceed with this idea in an effort to refocus ministry effort. Please remember that this group would not be a committee or have a budget, but would only serve as a think-tank for ministry emphasis. Any recommendations made by this group would require Church Council approval for action to be taken. The persons who have been asked to serve with this group are: Carlisle Dawsey and Missy Lewis to speak for NURTURE – two persons were asked because of the dual nature of Member Care / Dicipleship. Don Hopson for EVANGELISM, Michelle Altman for SERVICE and Gary Altman for WORSHIP. This group will hold meetings starting in January with the Pastor to develop ideas as how best to give emphasis to each of these areas for our church.

The Church Council of Aynor United Methodist Church was called to order on April 15, 2007 at 5:00 PM by Rev. Mardis. Chairman Ken Frye was not in attendance. The pastor opened the meeting prayer. Minutes were distributed and approved.

## Finance: Brad Dusenbury

1. Brad Dusenbury distributed Financial Report for the first quarter of 2007 (see attached). He indicated that we were running behind on giving to meet budget needs by almost \$7,000 thus far. The committee had discussed ways to make the congregation aware of this. One way will be to put financial reports in the bulletin each week. He also said that both he and the pastor would make an announcement in the next few weeks to the congregation asking for help in meeting the 2007 budget. One step that was taken by finance was to transfer back into the general fund the \$7500.00 paid to the building fund for first quarter in order to improve the cash balance of the checking account. He also reported that a special account was being set up for "flow through" monies collected by the church so that the general checking account would only reflect money to be used for the budget.

#### Trustees: Glen Winburn

- Indicated that they were working on improving the outside lighting. Spotlights
  have been added around the fellowship hall and the ones on the front of the
  church had been replaced.
- 2. The roof had been fixed in the Altman class.
- 3. Some of the exit lights need repair and they will get someone to do that in the near future.
- 4. Some areas of the church need painting, such as the area in the pulpit. Will look for someone to do this.
- 5. Still considering flooring for the fellowship hall. Several types have been looked at but it seems that commercial carpet is the cheapest and could be replaced

- several times for the cost of some materials. The trustees will continue to look into this.
- 6. Realize that they had spent much of their budget up to this point, but some things had not bee done in a while and maintenance on such a large building is expensive. They may be able to put off some things until later in the year but unless we keep up with things, they may become overwhelming.

## 2. NCD Survey

Thirty persons have been placed on a list to complete the survey form. The Natural Church Development process is one which weighs 8 indicators on a survey scored by the providers. From this, one area will be determined which indicates the greatest leverage for growth.
