To the Wofford Campus Community:

At approximately 3 p.m. today (Tuesday, November 4, 2008), we conducted our monthly test of the **Wofford Emergency Alert System**. These tests take place at the same time (typically 3 p.m.) on the first Tuesday of each month during the academic year.

The test generated a message delivered to **REGISTERED** and validated cell phones, PDAs, pagers, e-mails and Web browsers.

We're asking your assistance in helping us evaluate the system and encourage registrations.

- If you are registered and received the message on all registered devices, NO RESPONSE is needed.
- If you are registered, but **DID NOT** receive the message on all registered devices, please contact Laura Corbin at laura.corbin@wofford.edu. Please put "Emergency Alert System" in your subject line.
- If you have **NOT REGISTERED** to receive these messages, you are strongly urged to do so immediately at http://www.wofford.edu/campusSafety/content.aspx? id=33330.

Registrations have expired for many of you who were registered during the spring semester. You should have received notification 30 days before your accounts were to expire, reminding you to extend your registration. If you did not receive that notification, please contact Laura Corbin at laura.corbin@wofford.edu.

If you have not already done so, reinstate your registration:

- Go to: http://www.e2campus.com/my/wofford/index.htm
- Log into your account, which you created when you first registered.
- If you have forgotten your password, there is a link that will send you an e-mail with a new, temporary password, allowing you to log into the system; once there, you will be able to change your password.
- When you log in, you should receive a message that says your account has expired.
- Follow the instructions for reinstating the account and setting a new expiration date.
- We suggest that you set your account to be active through your graduation (if you are
 a student). Faculty/staff should set your expiration date as you desire. If necessary in
 the future, you may temporarily suspend your account (if you're traveling, for
 example), and you always have the option to cancel the account if you wish. (Of
 course, we urge you to keep your account current as long as you are associated with
 Wofford College.)

Wofford's Emergency Alert System is an instant, mass notification system that enables students, parents, and members of the faculty and professional staff to receive updates and alerts via cell phones, personal data assistants (PDAs), e-mail accounts, and personal Web

pages (such as Google, AOL, or Yahoo).

This service is part of our larger strategy to enhance communications during an emergency. Our goal is to increase safety on the Wofford College campus.

Wofford College Emergency Alert System is a completely voluntary service provided to the college community and is powered by Omnilert Network e2Campus. No advertisements or non-emergency alerts will be sent to you. You must sign up for the service in order to receive alerts. Because this is a voluntary service, you may choose to opt-in or opt-out of the service at any time.

You only have to register one time. Use either the cell phone or the e-mail sign up page, not both. Once you have an account, you can add to, or change, how you receive your messages. Links on the page take you to the appropriate sign up page.

Remember – e2Campus is an OPT-IN system, so you must handle the registration yourself. No one else can register you or update your account.

Student section to move behind Terrier bench

In a collaborative effort between Wofford Sports Marketing, the Wofford Athletic Ticket Office and several other campus agencies, fans will notice a few changes this year inside the Benjamin Johnson Arena when the Terrier basketball seasons begin one week from tonight as the women host Coastal Carolina.

Here is a brief rundown of the changes coming for 2008-09:

Student Section move - For years, the Wofford students have taken a traditional place in the center section (Section 3) of the West Stands inside the Arena. Beginning this year, the Wofford students will slide over to West sections 4 and 5 - directly behind the Terrier bench. The reasons behind this are two-fold...First, this allows the students to sit beside the new pep band. Secondly, it will allow the students to utilize the end of the West Concourse for special gatherings, giveaways specifically for students and potential pre-game social gatherings. There will be new signage installed in the Arena as well marking the newly moved Student Section.

"The Thundering Terriers" - Under the direction of Ron Miller, Wofford will have a pep band this basketball season. The pep band will perform for most men's and women's basketball games (excluding games over the holiday break). "Ron came to us with a concept for making a jazz ensemble style group function as a pep band for basketball and perform at many other College functions. We are grateful to him for his dedication and energy in making this group a major part of our in-game entertainment. If there is one thing I have heard over and over again about how to improve our basketball games it is to have a large, loud pep band and we will have that now," said Wofford assistant athletic director for marketing and promotions Lenny Mathis.

Family Section seating - In an attempt to have fans move lower in the seating bowl, the section formerly inhabited by the students (West Section 3) is now available on game-nights as a "Family Section." Fans how have the opportunity to purchase an adult ticket in this section for \$10 (normal reserved seat price) but children under the age of 12 will only be charged for the price of a child general admission ticket (\$5.00). Meaning a family of four can sit at mid-court for a total of \$30.

To the Wofford Community:

Members of Wofford's faculty have written an open letter in response to recent events on campus after the presidential election.

We believe strongly in the basic principles of a liberal arts education. As stated in the College's student handbook, these principles include "independence of thought, maturity of judgment, self-discipline, religious faith, and moral character" so as to develop the excellence in character necessary to become good citizens, effective leaders and generous servants of our communities. This letter intends to promote the principles of a liberal arts education and affirm Wofford's ongoing commitment to diversity and inclusiveness.

Our ability to pursue a liberal arts education depends upon an environment in which all members of the community can feel safe. Since the election, some students have shared stories with faculty about racist statements on Facebook accounts, in text messages, and on dry erase boards outside of individual dorm rooms. These actions have created a hostile climate for some and have no place on this campus or in any civil community.

The undersigned faculty categorically reject racism and bigotry in any form on this campus. Hateful speech toward any group violates the spirit of ethical inquiry in our community, and we join students in rejecting such despicable behavior.

Freedom of speech does not guarantee the right to intimidate and harass others. A true and principled democracy requires good faith efforts to act in a civil, mutually respectful and generous way with our fellow citizens. Disagreements based upon informed and substantive knowledge of policy encourage democracy; personal attacks based on ignorance and prejudice break it down.

The undersigned Wofford faculty call upon all members of this community to conduct themselves in ways that uphold the basic values of a democratic society, and look forward to informative and enriching conversations about the election and its consequences.
