# Burgess and Wofford in Fifth Place Following Day One of the Mid Pines Intercollegiate Sept. 9, 2003

Senior **Van Burgess** recorded a fifth place score of 73-66--139 (-5) to lead the Terrier men's golf team to a fifth place result out of 14 teams following the first two rounds of competition at the Mid Pines Intercollegiate in Southern Pines, N.C.

Teammate **Daniel Sloan** registered a 72-71--143 (-1) for the Terriers' other score under par after the first two rounds and is tied for 18th. **Jon Stephenson**'s 73-71--144 (E) gives Wofford three players at even or better and placement in the top 25 golfers of the tournament, as he is currently in a tie for 24th.

Other performers on the day for Wofford included **Adam Dox**, who recorded a 45th-place tying score of 77-72--149 (+5) and **Marshall Swails**, who is tied for 51st after posting a six-over par 73-77--150.

The tournament at the Mid Pines Inn and Golf Club will conclude with round three Tuesday.

# Terriers Shoot Five-Under Par to Tie Furman for Fifth Place Sept. 9, 2003

The Wofford men's golf team remained in the top half of the field at the Mid Pines Intercollegiate and tied rival Furman with a 291-280-288--859 (-5) for fifth place in the season opening tournament. The Terriers recorded the seventh lowest team score in the final round of competition at Mid Pines Inn and Golf Club in Southern Pines, N.C.

**Van Burgess** paced Wofford with an eighth place tying score of 73-66-73--212 (-4). Teammates **Jon Stephenson** (T22), 73-71-71--215 (-1), and **Daniel Sloan** (T25), 72-71-74--217 (+1) also placed in the top 25 golfers in the field.

Adam Dox tied for 34th with a five over par 77-72-72--221, while Marshall Swails concluded the Terrier effort with a 73-77-72--222 (+6) for a 41st place tie.

Wofford will next participate in the University of Louisville Intercollegiate, Sept. 29-30.

# Men's Golf Team, Ranked 34th, Travels to Louisville Sept. 28, 2003

The Wofford men's golf team will continue its fall season by traveling to Kentucky Monday and Tuesday to participate in the UofL Cardinal Collegiate.

In the latest rankings from Golfweek/Sagarin, the Terriers have garnered a 34th place ranking out of 149 Division I schools that have already played in a fall tournament. Wofford is the second highest ranked Southern Conference institution behind Georgia Southern (11th) and is ranked in the top 50 ahead of Furman (35th) and the College of Charleston (47th).

"We're riding on a pretty good high right now," said head coach **Dan O'Connell**. "The score we shot two weeks ago (at the Mid Pines Intercollegiate) was the lowest total in the 15 years since I've been coaching here. The guys have been working hard at it. This is a tournament in which we can be really competitive. If we played as well as we did two weeks ago, we could be right in the hunt.

"The ranking at this time of year is simply phenominial because of how many teams play Division I golf. To be in the top 10 percent of that group is awesome. The good news is the guys got a taste of how good it feels and how much fun it is to play well. We just have to go out and do it every time and be consistent."

The Terriers finished tied for fifth with Furman at the season opening Mid Pines Intercollegiate in Southern Pines, N.C., Sept. 8-9.

# Wofford Men's Golf Team Finishes 12th at Cardinal Intercollegiate Oct. 1, 2003

The Wofford Terrier men's golf team finished 12th out of 14 schools at the Cardinal Intercollegiate in Simpsonville, Ky. **Van Burgess** led the Terriers for the second straight tournament this fall, as Wofford placed ahead of Marquette and St. John's (N.Y.) at the competition hosted by Louisville at The Cardinal Club.

Burgess shot a 75-78-74--227 (+11) to tie with four others for 34th. Two Wofford golfers, **Daniel Sloan** (78-77-75--230/+14) and **Richard Cox** (80-73-77--230/+14) tied for 49th place.

Finishing up the Terrier scorers were **Jon Stephenson** who finished in 57th place with a 79-74-79--232 (+16) and **Adam Dox** who tied for 64th with scores of 84-75-80--239 (+23).

### O'Connell Signs One in Early Period for Men's Golf Next Season Nov. 24, 2003

After a successful fall season and a fourth-place finish in the Southern Conference last year, Wofford head men's golf coach **Dan O'Connell** has inked Columbia, S.C., native **Fielder Huntley** to a National Letter of Intent for 2004-05.

Huntley, a student at A.C. Flora High School, is the defending 3-A state individual champion and helped to guide his school to the state team crown in 2003. He garnered runner-up honors at the 2003 Florence Junior Invitational and Junior Azalea in addition to a fifth-place finish at the S.C. Junior Championship.

After guiding A.C. Flora to the state team title, the squad also won top honors at the 2003 South Carolina-Georgia Junior Team Challenge Matches.

Individually, he is currently ranked sixth in The Heritage Classic Foundation S.C. Junior rankings.

"We are very excited about Fielder coming to Wofford and look forward to having him compete for a spot in our starting lineup next fall," said O'Connell. "He has a successful record in both the high school season and in the highly competitive S.C. Junior Golf Association tournaments."

At A.C. Flora, he has garnered All-State and All-Region honors for three seasons and has led the team in scoring average since the eighth grade. Huntley has also been the team's MVP three straight years and was named the 3-A Player of the Year by *The State* in 2003.

The Wofford golf team finished in second place out of seven schools at the Lady Terrier Coca-Cola Intercollegiate at the Carolina Country Club this weekend in Spartanburg, S.C. East Tennessee State captured the team championship with a 651, one stroke better than Wofford's 652.

Freshman **Laura Parris** was the top Lady Terrier as she earned runner-up honors with a 76-78--154 (+10), five shots behind medalist Laura Terebey of Radford who garnered the individual champion slot with a five-over par, 73-76--149.

#### Wofford men's golf ties Davidson for sixth place at SoCon Championship April 20, 2004

With a three-over par 291 on the final day, the Wofford men's golf team moved into a tie for sixth at the Southern Conference Championship at The Ridges Golf and Country Club in Jonesborough, Tenn. The Terriers garnered a 36-over par (900) tournament to tie Davidson in the 12-team field.
