VARIOUS HISTORIES

A History of Orange Circuit Ebenezer United Methodist Church

The history of the Orange Circuit dates back to the early 1800's. However, in its current form it was established in 1989 to include Ebenezer United Methodist Church, St. John's United Methodist Church, and Trinity United Methodist Church.

The following section is reprinted in a condensed version from a historical accounting written by Mrs. Dell Jeffcoat in 1986. It is with much appreciation that we acknowledge her tireless effort to make sure that the history of Ebenezer is remembered by all.

Two hundred years ago in 1786, settlers were laying their claims to the land on which they had built their homes in this area. They were clearing land, raising families, building bridges. What about churches? Ebenezer came out of Jefcoats' Meeting House, so named for the Jefcoats who settled here. In 1790, there were six Jeffcoat men living here, six boys under sixteen and a number of females in addition to other settlers. When did they build a church?

The W.P.A. has on record at the Carolina Library that Ebenezer was established in 1808 and that Bishop Francis Asbury visited here. I found no proof of either statement.

Did these people of faith live here for more than twenty years before establishing a place of worship? We think not, and stand by Rev. Enoch Finklea and our beautiful sign by the road.

The crude log meeting house was an appointment to the Orange Circuit. There was a Quarterly Conference held there, the 15th and 16th of September 1820. Only four other meetings were recorded prior to this, the first being Cattle Creek, August 7, 1819. Jefcoats Meeting House was represented at each meeting:

The circuits were so large and the appointments so many, a circuit rider came by only once a month. A total of forty-five circuit riders had served the Meeting House from 1820 to 1841, the most famous being Rev. A. McCorquodale from Scotland and the Junior preacher Rev. A. M. Crietzburg who served the Orangeburg District seven years. Later as Dr. Crietzburg, he is the author of Early Methodism in the Carolinas and mentions Jefcoats' Meeting House in his book.

The church was moved to the Hollow Creek Circuit in 1825; Barnwell Circuit, Charleston District in 1833; and back to Orangeburg Circuit in 1840. There were many moves in the long history of this church.

In 1832 or '33, the log meeting house was replaced with a crude frame building with board shutters on the windows. There were two front doors and wide steps extending across the front.

During the mid-1840's the meeting house was deeded to the Methodist Episcopal Church by Urbane E. Jeffcoat. The meeting house is referred to as Ebenezer for the first time at a Quarterly Conference meeting held at Saddlers Swamp Campgrounds October 3, 1845.

On February 2, 1865, the church, caught in the crossfire of Sherman's troops and the Confederate militia, was hit and ignited. The fire was extinguished by Walter T. Harley. This church was torn down and a new one was begun during the pastorate of Ed Smith, 1899, or O. A. Jeffcoat, 1900. When Rev. J. K. Inabinet came here in December of 1902, the church was "hulled in," to quote him and "completed in the fall of 1902."

The new church was a long frame building like the previous one, but the interior was finished and it had glass windows. It was dedicated by Dr. J. A. Clifton, November 9, 1902. His text was Ephesians 3:21. The Trustees were W.D. Harley, J.A. Fleming, and W.Q. Jackson. The stewards were W.D. Harley, W.N. King, and R.B. Hydrick.

The first "Woman's Missionary Society" was organized October 15, 1916 by Mrs. Ollie Schoenberg. The charter members were Mrs. Schoenberg, Mrs. A.M. Reed, Mrs. J.C. Kennerly, Mrs. L. M. Jeffcoat, Mrs. Lillie Jeffcoat, and Mrs. Bessie Jeffcoat.

Mr. Jeff King was possibly the first Sunday School Superintendent. He died in 1895. Mrs. Lucille Jeffcoat said that he, his son Wilson, and grandson Webster served at one time, alternating Sundays. Mr. W. H. Jeffcoat began serving about 1913 and served for about forty-eight years. Others who have served are Lewis Kennerly, Tom Jackson, Alvin Roof, Wilson Jeffcoat, and presently Mike Jeffcoat.

The first musical instrument was a tiny organ purchased in 1875. Mrs. Rachel H. Livingston was the first organist. Many organist and pianist have served since then, the present being Roger Jeffcoat, who has served about twenty-five years.

During the pastorate of D.E. Jeffcoat (1922-25) Sunday School rooms were added; the entrance and windows were changed also. This was the church I came to as a bride in 1939. I loved this church where my six children were brought up, but something happened in the sixties and the church was scarcely lukewarm and attendance was very poor.

Then in 1967, Rev. Enoch Finklea came -- warm compassionate, loving, filled with the Holy Spirit beaming with such joy and excitement that the dying ember that was Ebenezer burst into a flame under his guidance and the attendance grew.

Memories are made of these: A joyous fellowship saturating the church surpassing anything we had ever known before. Working together, fund raising projects, increased offerings, an overflowing crowd for the last happy-sad homecoming in the old church, May 1969. Going to the community center for Sunday AM Worship that winter and early spring. Getting out of bed at sunrise to open the door for our pastor exploding with excitement over the progress being made on the church building, or some other new idea he had in mind. Homecoming in the beautiful new church May 4, 1969. Elsie Rast organized a choir. She and Lou Ellen Jeffcoat cutting robes from pretty blue material. Too many memories to put in this space!

We are looking forward to exciting things happening this year; a comprehensive study of First John by the entire church in the classrooms and preached from the pulpit, Vernon Bauer is in charge; a special Easter service; Homecoming in May; a great Veterans Day Celebration, and many other happenings. To God be the glory!

ADDENDUM:

Since 1986, Rev. Finklea retired and Ebenezer joined the Orange Circuit in 1989. In 2003, a new Women's Circle was chartered as the Faith Circle and in its first year of existence was designated a Five-Star unit and received a mission award.

Every year the vacation Bible School sets a new record for attendance. It continues to be one of the church's most effective programs.

Ebenezer United Methodist Church continues to be a beacon for Christ on the hill at Poole's Mill.

To write a history of Ebenezer church would be a task much too hard for me. It would take several months or probably a year or two.

This is just a few of my early recollections of the church as it was, when I was a child, and later ~~at~~ ^{when} I was a young woman. When I was a child I was told by older members of the church that the first church at this place was a log cabin. It was adorned on top of the roof with a large round piece of heart pine. Mrs. Mary Schumpert told me the story of seeing the piece of wood lying among the grass and weeds around the place and the ruins of the old chimney.

The second church, the one where I went to Sunday School and preaching was a large frame building. There was no ceiling in the church and no sash in

the windows. There were board shutters to the windows. On cold days with the windows closed, it was quite dark in the church. The floor of the old church was of wide boards, perhaps around nine or ten inches wide and hand dressed.

It ^{was} about 1896 or 1897 that the old church was torn down and plans for a new building were started. The present church was completed in the Fall of 1902 and dedicated in October or November of that year.

The dedication sermon was preached by Dr. Jesse A. Clifton, and it was a wonderful sermon. Mr. Sam Lindall led the singing.

The first Pastor that I remember was the Rev. A. A. Furguson. He served four years and was sent to another place for just one year. A petition was sent to Conference asking for Mr. Furguson to be sent back here.

Mr. Ferguson came back for four more years, and then was sent to another place for one year.

After serving one year at this other place, the people here petitioned for him again, and he was returned to us for another four year period. That made twelve years. Then our next Pastor was Rev.

Daniel Schumpert.

He was greatly loved by everyone. In the Fall of 1886 after the terrible Charleston earthquake, the people were excited and very much upset. Many thought that judgement day was near, and lived in fear of another earthquake at any time. It was at that time that Mr. Schumpert was wise enough to see what was needed. He held a two weeks meeting, and by his wonderful preaching and sound advice calmed the people, and befriended them in many ways. He was like one of the Prophets of Bible Times.

Many people professed conversion and forty new members were added to the church. The memory of "Uncle" Schumpert will always be revered by the older people of this community.

Rev. Ed Smith preached for us a couple of years in the late nineties but I don't remember the exact dates. Rev. C. A. Jefcoat preached at Ebenezer for me or two years. He was just beginning then, but everyone saw and prophesied a successful career for him, which proved to be correct. The people of Ebenezer regard him with deep appreciation and sincere affection. I find that I have left out the name of Dr. Lucius W. Bellenger. He was Pastor of Ebenezer for two years, I think it was in 1887 & 1888. Ebenezer and Hopewell were on the Orange circuit with Hebron and Penn Branch at that time.

District here.

Ebenezer History

The earliest written records that we have of Ebenezer Methodist Church were found in an old church register of Orangeburg Circuit - ~~dating~~ ^{to} 1858. When Ebenezer was on the Orangeburg Circuit along with five other churches - Calvary, Andrew's Chapel, Trinity, Sharon and Gethsemane.

However we know that Ebenezer Church existed before that time as 25 acres of land on which to build the church was given by Urbane E. Joffcoat who was born in 1821 and died at the age of 86 years in 1867. (This Urbane E. Joffcoat being the grandfather of the present Church School Supt. Willie H. Joffcoat & Rev. O. A. Joffcoat a former pastor - and others) I have been told by older people that Bishop Asbury preached at this church while passing through the country on his horse back journeys over a wide territory. This old Orangeburg Circuit register which was kept by my uncle Jack Hydrick of Trinity Church shows that Ebenezer Society as it was then called had 39 names on roll in 1858. Names of men and women who have through the years labored to keep the church alive and ministering to the spiritual needs of the community -

One of these who labored long and faithfully was Wilson King - Supt of the Church School for many years. Born 1844 - died 1916 - at the age of 72 years. He set an example of faithful service that will ever be remembered.

His son Webster King was Assistant Supt and Teacher, Steward and Trustee for many years. faithfully giving of his best until his death.

Our present Supt of the Church ^{school} has faithfully served the Church ^{continually} since 1913 a period of 41 years - and we hope that he will be able to continue much longer.

The women too have labored in the interest of this church - many names could be mentioned both men and women who love the old church and have been faithful and able workers - but among these credit must be given to Mrs Ollie Schoenberg who organized the first missionary society here in 1916 which is still functioning. She also taught in many various

local name from
across the Edisto river. Then others advanced
the theory that it was called Jeffers Church
because the land on which it stands was once
owned by a Jeffers. However that is, it is
true, that this family name is borne by many
in the community.

It is interesting to note that in this old church
register the names of the men were in one
place and those of the women were in a separate
place. I am told that in the old church the
custom was for the men to occupy one side
of the church and the women the other.
The records in this old register gives the
names of pastors and presiding elders
covering a period of time from 1838 to
Dec 18, 1875 - which was 17 years.

I am sorry to say that there is no written record
available at this time between 1875 and 1890
about fifteen years that we have no written record
of but beginning in 1890 when the present
building was in the process of being built. Our
records are fairly complete to the present time

According to The Church record books at this
time June, 28th 1950. Rev. O. A. Jeffcoat served
this church as pastor for some time prior to 1900
or during that year. Bishop Joseph A. Key ^{President} H. B. Brown
In Dec 1900. Rev. J. N. Inabinet was sent to the
Wagner charge. He served two years 1901 + 1902
Bishop R. H. Hargrove was the presiding Bishop with
Rev. H. B. Brown presiding Elder.
The second year he served us he was sent to us
by Bishop C. B. Galloway.
Dec. 1902. Rev. J. C. Holley was sent to Wagner
charge by Bishop W. H. Duncan, presiding Elder
was Rev. Martin Wargan. Mr. Holley served this
