We will use these parameters in assessing applicants in the weeks ahead. The search profile continues to be available for your review at www.wofford.edu.

Our advertising continues to appear this month in *The Chronicle of Higher Education*, *Inside Higher Ed*, *Women in Higher Education*, *Hispanic Outlook*, *Diverse Jobs*, *The Journal of Blacks in Higher Education*, *HigherEdJobs*, *American Conference of Academic Deans*, and the *United Methodist Church website*. We have distributed roughly 2,300 search profiles nationally to inform selected individuals about the search and to request their suggestions of persons we should consider.

We ask again that you too suggest people who might be attractive to Wofford in this search. Dr. Tom Courtice is stepping away from consulting at this time, and we are pleased that Dr. Melinda Leonardo, who was the "co-consultant" on this search, is now assuming full responsibility for working with our committee. The nominations and suggestions that we receive from those closest to the college can be among the most meaningful.

We will review application materials throughout this month and we plan to meet again early in January to evaluate our general progress and to begin reducing the candidate pool to a smaller group. 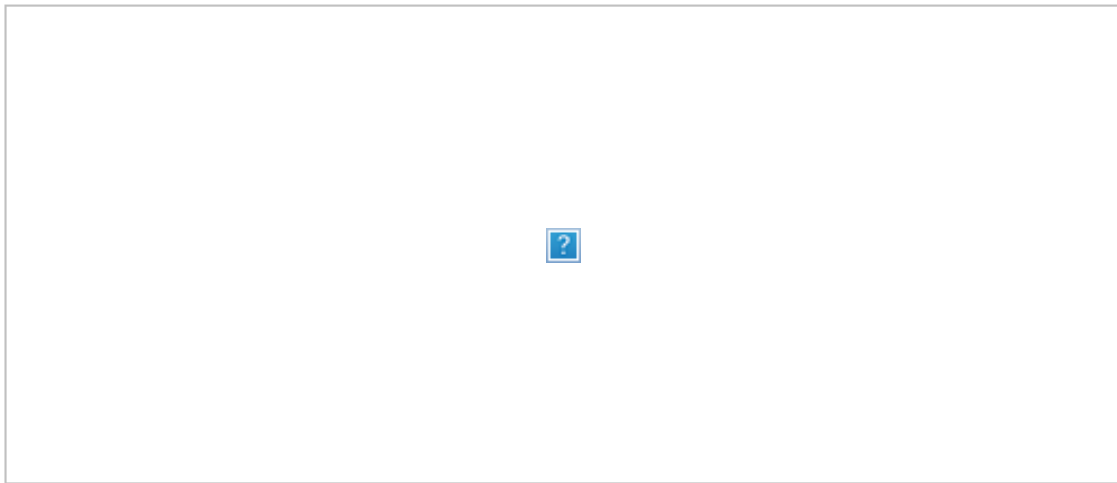

SUMMARY ANNUAL REPORT

For Wofford College Defined Contribution Retirement Plan

This is a summary of the annual report for Wofford College Defined Contribution Retirement Plan, EIN 57-0314422, Plan No. 001, for period January 1, 2014 through December 31, 2014. The annual report has been filed with the Employee Benefits Security Administration, U.S. Department of Labor, as required under the Employee Retirement Income Security Act of 1974 (ERISA).

Basic Financial Statement

Benefits under the plan are provided by insurance and a trust fund. Plan expenses were \$5,645,038. These expenses included \$5,645,038 in benefits paid to participants and beneficiaries. A total of 680 persons were participants in or beneficiaries of the plan at the end of the plan year, although not all of these persons had yet earned the right to receive benefits.

The value of plan assets, after subtracting liabilities of the plan, was \$61,946,961 as of December 31, 2014, compared to \$61,123,098 as of January 1, 2014. During the plan year the plan experienced an increase in its net assets of \$823,863. This increase includes unrealized appreciation and depreciation in the value of plan assets; that is, the difference between the value of the plan's assets at the end of the year and the value of the assets at the beginning of the year or the cost of assets acquired during the year. The plan had total income of \$6,468,901, including employer contributions of \$1,840,504, employee contributions of \$903,561, other contributions of \$41,184 and earnings from investments of \$3,683,652.
