In the cases of two available shifts for the same day/duties (kickoff party), you may volunteer for both shifts. You may select as many slots as you wish. Then, hit "submit" at the bottom of the form. You will be informed via email of your assignments and any special instructions.

Slots will be filled on a first-come basis and as needs necessitate. You are not guaranteed a slot. If your requested slots are filled, your name will be kept on a waiting list and you will be notified if a slot becomes available.

All volunteers must be at least 18 years of age.
