## **Terrier men's golf sets 2006-07 dates September 8, 2006**

SPARTANBURG, S.C. -- The Wofford men's golf team and head coach Vic Lipscomb have announced their 2006-07 schedule, beginning with the Mid Pines Intercollegiate Monday and Tuesday in Southern Pines, N.C.

The Terriers, who welcome back 2006 Southern Conference Freshman of the Year Neil O'Briain, will also play at the Raines Development Group Intercollegiate in Florence, S.C., and at the Sea Trail Intercollegiate in Sunset Beach, N.C., during the month of September.

Wofford then travels to Howey-in-the-Hills, Fla., Oct. 6-8 for the Mission Inn Collegiate Classic before competing in the Buffalo Rock "Southern Showdown" Oct. 30-31 in McCalla, Ala. The Fall tournament lineup concludes Nov. 4-5 at the WCU Intercollegiate in Hendersonville, N.C.

A road trip right down I-26 to Clinton, S.C., and the Presbyterian College Intercollegiate Feb. 19-20 kicks off the Spring portion of the schedule. Before the month is over, the Terriers will also play Feb. 26-27 at the Wexford Plantation Intercollegiate in Hilton Head, S.C.

In March, the Samford Intercollegiate March 11-13 in Oneonta, Ala., and the Furman Intercollegiate March 23-25 in Greenville, S.C., are included on the Wofford slate.

The Terriers then will host the 20th annual Wofford Invitational presented by Vault April 2-3 at The Carolina Country Club in Spartanburg. Wofford wraps up its campaign April 22-24 at the Southern Conference Championship at The Country Club of South Carolina in Florence, S.C.

## **O'Briain races to six-shot lead after day one at Mid Pines September 11, 2006**

SOUTHERN PINES, N.C. -- Wofford sophomore Neil O'Briain carded a 67-65--132 (-12) to take a six-shot lead into the final day Tuesday as the Terriers' men's golf team opened its 2006-07 campaign at the Mid Pines Intercollegiate in Southern Pines, N.C.

O'Briain, the reigning Southern Conference Freshman of the Year and All-Southern Conference selection, was the only golfer in the field of 88 players to post under 70 scores on both 18-hole rounds Monday.

Mike McKenzie, a freshman, was also under par for the Terriers with an eighth-place tying 71-69--140 (-4). Wofford is just one of four schools out of the 17-team tournament to have at least two players in the top 10 individuals.

Sophomore Drew Perry, the November 2005 SoCon Player of the Month, registered a 73-74--147 (+3) to tie for 39th, while junior John Gault posted a 63rd-place tying tally of 78-73--151 (+7).

Rounding out the Terriers was sophomore Matt Mielke with a 78-80--158 (+14) to tie for 80th.

The three-round par 72 event covering 6,528 yards will conclude with the third and final round Tuesday.

## **O'Briain finishes second as Terriers place sixth September 12, 2006**

SOUTHERN PINES, N.C. -- Wofford sophomore Neil O'Briain garnered a second-place finish among the 88 individuals as the Terriers recorded a sixth-place team result at the 2006-07 season-opening Mid Pines Intercollegiate in Southern Pines, N.C.

O'Briain, who was tabbed the Southern Conference's Freshman of the Year last year and was an All-SoCon pick, finished one shot behind medalist Ryan Spears of Wichita State. O'Briain carded a 67-65-74--206 (-10) and was the leader after the first two rounds of the tournament.

Freshman Mike McKenzie, participating in his first collegiate event, tallied a 71-69-75--215 (-1) to tie for 13th overall.

Sophomore Drew Perry, the November 2005 SoCon Player of the Month, tied for 45th after posting a 73-74-75--222 (+6). Junior John Gault tied for 64th with an 11-over par 78-73-76--227.

Rounding out the Wofford scores was sophomore Matt Mielke with an 82nd-place tying finish of 78-80-78--236 (+20).

The Terriers' sixth-place result came after team scores of 289-281-300--870 (+6) on the par 72, 6,528-yard course.

Spears shot an 11-under par 75-63-67--205 for the victory, while Wisconsin claimed the team title with a 282-280-285--847 (-17).

Wofford will resume its campaign Sept. 18-19 at the Raines Development Group Intercollegiate at The Country Club of South Carolina in Florence, S.C.

## **Medeiros paces Terrier men's golf at second fall tournament September 19, 2006**

FLORENCE, S.C. -- Freshman Garrett Medeiros, competing in his first collegiate tournament, was the top Wofford individual as the Terriers tied for ninth at the Raines Development Group Intercollegiate Monday and Tuesday at The Country Club of South Carolina in Florence, S.C.

Medeiros fired a 4-over par 69-74-77--220 to tie for 17th among the 95 individuals on the par 72, 7,062-yard course. He finished one shot ahead of sophomore teammates Neil O'Briain (72-73-76--221) and Drew Perry (73-70-78--221), who tied for 24th with their 5-over par scores.

Fellow rookie Mike McKenzie posted a 74-77-78--229 (+13) to tie for 62nd, while junior John Gault rounded out the Wofford squad with an 84th-place tying 76-80-80--236 (+20).

As a team, the Terriers carded a 288-294-309--891 (+27) to tie USC-Aiken and Charleston Southern for ninth. Jacksonville earned the team title with a 10-over par 293-281-300--874.

The Dolphins' Duncan Stewart took home medalist honors with a 3-under par 69-71-73--213 and outlasting Old Dominion's Stan Guerrero and Troy's Jordy Hayden on the third playoff hole.

Wofford will next compete Sept. 23-24 at the Sea Trail Intercollegiate in Sunset Beach, N.C.

## **Terrier men's golf finishes first day at Sea Trail September 23, 2006**

SUNSET BEACH, N.C. -- The Wofford men's golf team shot a 12-over par 300 to place 15th after day one competition at the Sea Trail Intercollegiate Saturday in Sunset Beach, N.C.

The Terriers, who were sending their No. 6-10 qualifiers, were led by freshman Kirk Whitehead, who tallied a 35-38--73 (+1) to tie for 27th. One shot behind him was senior Dustin Adair, in a tie for 36th, with a 37-37--74 (+2).

Junior Matt Davis carded a 37-39--76 (+4) to tie for 57th, one stroke ahead of rookie James Walker who registered a 40-37--77 (+5) to tie for 68th. Jonathan Strauss rounded out the Wofford individuals with a 42-38--80 (+8) to tie for 88th.

Of the five players, only Adair and Davis have competed in a collegiate event prior to this weekend.

James Madison leads the team standings with a 4-under par 284, while reigning Southern Conference Player of the Year Matt Cook of Western Carolina is tied with Kennesaw State's Kris Sheperd for the top individual nod as both posted 5-under par 67s.

The tournament will continue Sunday at the 6,761-yard, par 72 course.

## **Whitehead finishes as top Terrier in first tournament September 24, 2006**

SUNSET BEACH, N.C. -- Freshman Kirk Whitehead shot even par Sunday and finished in a tie for 17th overall as he led the Wofford men's golf team at his first collegiate tournament at the Sea Trail Intercollegiate in Sunset Beach, N.C.

Whitehead was among five players tied for 17th after he carded a 1-over par 73-72--145. He finished three shots ahead of senior Dustin Adair, who registered a 74-74--148 (+4) to tie for 32nd.

Junior Matt Davis tallied a 79th-place tying 76-79--155 (+11), while rookie James Walker matched his result with a 77-78--155 (+11).

Jonathan Strauss rounded out the Terrier individuals with a 93rd-place finish after notching an 80-79--159 (+15). Wofford's five players were its No. 6-10 qualifiers and not the usual starting five.

Wofford placed 18th as a team with a 300-303--603 (+27), while Western Carolina captured the title with a 286-285--571 (-5). The Catamounts' Matt Cook, the reigning Southern Conference Player of the Year, held off Kennesaw State's Kris Sheperd to win the individual medalist crown in a playoff after both players fired a 67-67--134 (-10).

The Terriers will continue their fall campaign Oct. 6-8 at the Mission Inn Collegiate Classic in Howey-in-the-Hills, Fla.

October 19, 2006**

WILTON, Conn. -- The Wofford men's and women's golf programs were rated among the NCAA's best in a recent study on collegiate programs conducted by Golf Digest magazine.




Golf Digest used six factors, each on a graded curve, to determine each school's overall score. All 772 men's programs and 500 women's programs were ranked based on the categories, which included team adjusted scoring average (40 percent), player growth (9.75 percent times 2), academics (14 percent), climate (12 percent) and coaches/facilities (14.5 percent).

The Terrier men, under head coach Vic Lipscomb, are among the top 17 percent nationally after their ranking of No. 127 of 772. Wofford's placement is highlighted by a top 20 percent ranking for coaches/facilities and top 30 percent listing for the team's adjusted scoring average and climate.

In the list of top 150 programs found online (<http://www.golfdigest.com/features/index.ssf?/features/gd200609collegemengolf.html>), Wofford was ahead of schools such as Kansas, Coastal Carolina, Notre Dame, Florida State, Louisville, Colorado, Mississippi State and Penn State.


On the women's side, the Terriers are No. 138 out of 500 for a place among the top 28 percent of schools nationwide. The team, under head coach Angie Ridgeway, earned marks in the top 30 percent for coaches/facilities and climate.

Wofford's ranking was ahead of Southern Miss, Washington State, Harvard, Fresno State and Western Kentucky on the online top-150 list (<http://www.golfdigest.com/features/index.ssf?/features/gd200609collegewomengolf.html>).

## **Wofford men's golf wins WCU Intercollegiate title November 5, 2006**

ETOWAH, N.C. -- The Wofford men's golf squad captured the team title Sunday at the WCU Intercollegiate by virtue of a playoff against Winthrop at the Etowah Valley Country Club in Etowah, N.C. The two teams tied but the Terriers were awarded the championship as a result of a scorecard playoff involving the No. 5 player for each team.

Wofford fired a 293-293--586 (+10) and held off a late-rallying Winthrop squad which carded a 297-289--586 (+10) on the 7,056-yard, par 72 course. The Eagles' Pete Alminas nailed a hole-in-one on No. 17 to spark Winthrop.

The Terriers were led by freshman Mike McKenzie, who tied for third with a 73-71--144 (E). Among the trio he was tied with was Western Carolina's Matt Cook, the top-rated player in Division I by golfstat.com and the reigning Southern Conference Player of the Year.

Fellow rookie Garrett Medeiros tied for 13th after registering a 72-74--146 (+2). Sophomore Drew Perry posted a 77-72--149 (+5) to tie for 21st.

Teammates Kirk Whitehead, a freshman, and sophomore Neil O'Briain finished within one shot of each other. Whitehead tallied a 72-79--151 (+7) to tie for 31st, while O'Briain tied for 33rd with a 76-76--152 (+8).

Tennessee Tech's Scott Stallings was declared the individual medalist after he recorded a 72-68--140 (-4) and finished as one of two players under par.

Wofford concludes its fall slate with the tournament and will resume action in February at the Presbyterian College Intercollegiate in Clinton, S.C.
