



Last night we held a virtual town hall event for the campus, and today we would like to share a general update on the state of the college for those who missed the event. 
We continue to monitor public health and governmental recommendations regarding COVID-19. Social distancing remains a priority and informs how we work safely while maintaining the vital functions of the college.

- The college remains committed to employees. Through the end of the fiscal year (June 30), unless stay-at-home orders are lifted and it becomes safe to gather, employees and departments should continue to follow the current plan of working flexibly on campus or from home in support of students, colleagues and the academic program. Because we do not know yet what COVID-19 will bring, we all can do our part to protect employment for all; please be aware that it is absolutely critical to avoid all non-essential expenses of any type at this time, and note that a hiring freeze remains in effect.
- The college is planning a Commencement celebration for the Class of 2020 on Friday, August 21, and Saturday, August 22. Details will follow soon. Of course, this event is contingent upon the ability to gather at that time.
- Faculty are considering options to shift to remote instruction for either or both of the summer sessions this year. We hope to make a decision within the next week.
- Enrollment and retention remain robust. We are ahead of where we were last year, which bodes well for Wofford's ability to weather this pandemic. The college has considered a variety of fiscal scenarios for this year and the next academic year and continues to update those as we gain additional information.

At this point, we do not know what the fall will bring, but again, we are considering a variety of options and looking creatively at the academic calendar should we need to make those complicated decisions. Please know that we all want to be back on campus — together in our mission of teaching, mentoring and learning — and we continue to hope for that, as well as for the safety of our community.
