

As the new academic year and the return of our students to campus approaches, we want to provide you with important information regarding move-in and early move-in for groups faculty and/or staff may advise. First-year students will arrive on Saturday, Aug. 28 and our returning students will arrive beginning on Monday, Aug. 30.

Experience tells us, however, that many of our students have pre-season trainings, opportunities for community engagement, professional development, and other commitments that bring them to campus before our official move-in days. The Office of Residence Life works diligently to support students and colleagues with housing for their early arrival needs each fall. This year our ability to grant early arrival requests is significantly limited due to the shifting campus calendar, residence hall renovations and the calendar for summer camps.

Because of these factors outside of our control, over 60% of our beds on campus will be occupied by off-campus groups or offline completely for renovations until late-August. Therefore:

Early Arrival Groups

Groups requesting early arrival will not be able to access campus housing until at least Wednesday, Aug. 24. **Group advisors/staff leaders should submit requests for early arrival by emailing <u>reslife@wofford.edu</u>before Friday, July 2. We encourage group leaders and advisors to begin planning with this in mind.**

Individual Early Arrivals

Individual returning students needing to return before upper-class move-in will not be able to do so before Aug. 29. An early arrival request form will be available on the Housing Portal beginning in early July. All individual requests for early arrival must be submitted through that form by Friday, Aug. 20.

As a reminder, all early arrival requests will still need to be submitted to the Office of Residence Life for approval.

It is always our goal to support our students and the many outstanding programs offered here at Wofford. We also understand that we must plan with reality in mind, and the time, energy, and labor required by our facilities, housekeeping and residence life teams to turn over more than 1,000 beds before Aug. 24 is already a herculean task. We appreciate your understanding.
