



**Details:** Presence and Protest is a lecture by artist, educator, and curator Justin Randolph Thompson that draws upon On Being Present, a two-year research project dedicated to representations of Black Africans in the paintings and drawings of the collection of the Gallerie degli Uffizi and Palazzo Pitti, curated by Thompson for the Hypervisions online platform. The talk reflects upon institutional positionality and the fragility of facades designed to overlook a presence hidden in plain sight. What does it mean for the recognition of something as simple as presence in the visual archive to be capable of unsettling canons developed and upheld for centuries? What does it say to us about the role of institutions in caring for a more complete narration of their collections? In September of 2020 Thompson and the initiative that he co-founded and currently directs, Black History Month Florence, opened a Black cultural center in the heart of Florence called The Recovery Plan. This lecture grapples with what it means to recover from the abuse of these culturally induced oversights, while recovering fragments of history that are far from lost, they are simply in need of maintenance and care. The lecture draws upon "On Being Present," a two-year research project dedicated to representations of Black Africans in the paintings and drawings of the collection of the Gallerie degli Uffizi and Palazzo Pitti, curated by Thompson for the Hypervisions online platform. Thompson will reflect upon institutional positionality and the fragility of facades designed to overlook a presence hidden in plain sight. What does it mean for the recognition of something as simple as presence in the visual archive to be capable of unsettling canons developed and upheld for centuries? What does it say to us about the role of institutions in caring for a more complete narration of their collections? In September of 2020 Thompson and the initiative that he co-founded and currently directs, Black History Month Florence, opened a Black cultural center in the heart of Florence called The Recovery Plan. This lecture grapples with what it means to recover from the abuse of these culturally induced oversights, while recovering fragments of history that are far from lost, they are simply in need of maintenance and care. 

# New Wofford College Bookstore in 2022

The Wofford College Bookstore will soon have a new home in a shopping plaza that will include restaurants, retail and gathering spaces.

The college participated in a groundbreaking ceremony Wednesday, Nov. 10, for The Hub, a 16,699-square-foot shopping center that will be located at 578 N. Church St.

"The Hub is an exciting development that will complement revitalization efforts for the city's Northside and Wofford's continued integration across Church Street into the Northside community," said Dr. Tim Schmitz, Wofford's interim provost, who has overseen a 2015 grant from the Romill Foundation for the Milliken Sustainability Initiative to support the college's involvement in the neighborhood.

The Hub is expected to be complete by summer 2022.

The college's bookstore will relocate from 501 N. Church St. to The Hub. The bookstore will have 5,758 square-feet of flexible space for the display and sale of merchandise and books with the capacity to serve as the site of college and community events. The college also will share outdoor space for gatherings with others in the plaza.

Moe's Original BBQ will occupy a 3,271 square-foot space in the plaza. More restaurants, retail and commercial users are being recruited for the shopping center.
