You are hereby commanded to receive into the prison
of said County the body of Levi Bowers and him
safely keep so that you have him before the
next Court of said county to answer the
charge of the State against him for committing
an assault and battery on the body of Julia
a female slave the property of Alex^r and
Nelson now in the employment of
Henry L Stephenson or is thence discharged
by due course of Law hereof all not
given under my hand & seal this 28th
day of Oct 1841
